

# DRINFO in a nutshell



DRINFO runs a bunch of queries on your data once a month



It will find data and process **gaps** at your practice where patients have fallen through, or possibly about to fall.

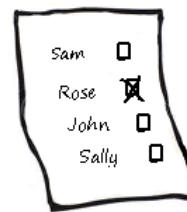
And list of patients who may develop health problems if you do not proactively see them, including those who were not put on a recall at all



You know, like all these claims your system did not submit ... flu, diabetes checks, Care+ enrolments and others



It is so much easier than building and running your own queries ... every month!



You simply get a list of names to take action on for each gap found

Wherever possible, DRINFO will also help you with the action itself ... like sending recall letters to the patients' postal address ... in a mouse-click! (Yes, no printing and folding letters!)



You can even be **SMART** and use one combined patient list (SMART Recalls), with one flexible "health-check" letter per patient, recalling for all that they are due for.



DRINFO gives you monthly performance reporting, to make sure you can measure your improvements and compare yourself with other practices (anonymised) it is, after all, used by most practices in New Zealand.

So, when DRINFO helps you achieve results ... you can give yourself a good old pat on the back!! ... Or maybe even a pay-rise!
